

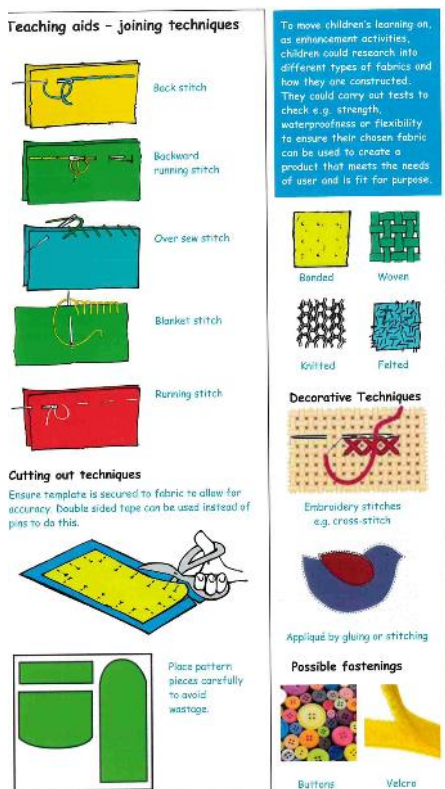

KS1 (Year 1/2) Templates and Joining Techniques



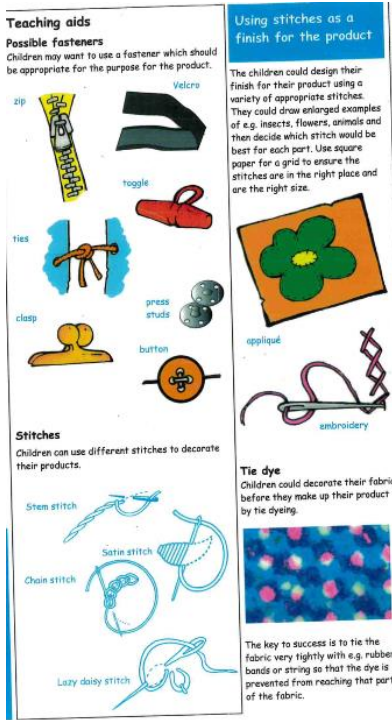
- Make a template.
- Tape in position the template on the fabric, pins to secure the template to the fabric and then cut around it.

- Exploring different joining techniques of fabric- glue, stapling, sewing.
- Finishing techniques- decoration- buttons, colouring pens, sequins, other fabrics.



Early KS2 (Year 3/4) 2D Shape to 3D Product

- Different stitches.
- Exploring different fabrics- felt, knitted, woven.
- Choosing fabric that is best for the job.
- Finishing techniques- decoration- stitches to decorate.
- Possible fastenings- buttons, velcro



Late KS2 (Year 5/6) Combining Different Fabric Shapes

- Different fastenings- buttons, velcro, zip, ties, toggles.
- Picking the stitch that is most appropriate for the job.
- Range of different stitches to decorate product.
- Range of different decoration techniques- tie dye
- CAD- Computer Aided Design- using computer to help aid design of product.
