Learning to sing or play a musical instrument can be an immensely valuable experience which will enrich your child's life. There is clear evidence showing that participation in regular musical activity has a positive impact on academic achievement, as well as social and emotional development.

HMS provides high quality teachers who are developed and monitored through regular CPD and performance management and supported with HMS schemes of work and resources. Students are taught mostly in groups, promoting ensemble skills and preparing them for joining bands and orchestras, but this will be dependent on instruments being learnt and their learning level.

Celebration and assessment of progress is through the HMS Certificates of Achievement – Beginner, Introductory and Stages 1-8.

HMS charges the school for providing the teacher for the amount of time requested by the school. The school have their own policy on how they pass charges onto parents. HMS teachers are available for teaching each week apart from HMS inset days and an organised PPA session each term.
