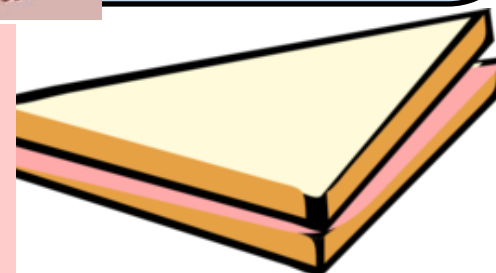


How to Make a Ham Sandwich

THE PLOT AGAINST THE EMPEROR

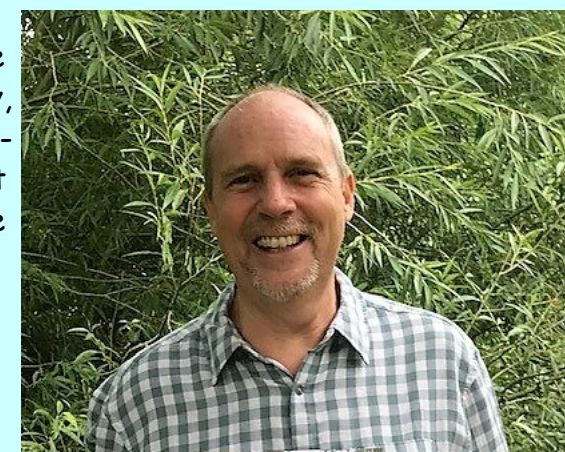

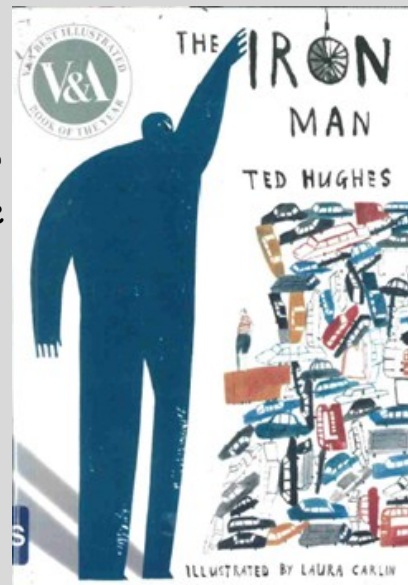
All About The Iron Man

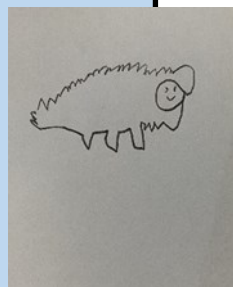
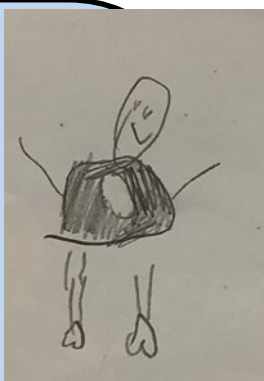
