

Child Safety – Please may we remind you that staff are not out on duty on the playgrounds at the end of the school day. When children are released from the classroom doors, responsibility for supervision transfers back to the parent/carer. It is important that adults ensure their children are playing in a safe manner and behaving in an appropriate way.
