

Parents' Evenings – The final **Face to Face** Parents' Evenings of this year for **ALL** year groups takes place on **Tuesday 14 July (3:30pm/8:00pm)** and **Wednesday 15 July (3:30pm/6:00pm)**.

Lee Haywood from Online Safety UK will be available on both evenings to discuss online safety or provide some practical assistance in understanding how to put child safety measures into your electronic devices.

*Please note that the children will be finishing early on these days to allow the teachers to get themselves set up for their appointments. **Infants will be dismissed at 3:05pm and Juniors will be dismissed at 3:15pm**, please arrange for your child to be picked up at this earlier time.*

Road Safety – A member of the public has expressed their concern over one of our pupils who regularly rides home along Church Road without his hands on the handlebars! If this is your child please can you ask them to not do this as it has the potential to cause a serious, possibly fatal accident.

Year 6 Leavers' Hoodies – Year 6 children will be able to wear their leavers' hoodies to school next week (**Monday 13 July through to Monday 20 July**). We would however ask that they return to normal school uniform for their final day at school on Tuesday 21 July.

Summer Reading Challenge "Read to the beat" – This year's challenge starts this Saturday, 11 July and children can take part online <https://summerreadingchallenge.org.uk/> or in person at their local library.

Children aged 4 - 11 can read or listen to 6 books over the summer, collect stickers and receive a medal and certificate.

Leavers' Service – We will be holding our annual leavers' service during the morning of **Tuesday 21 July at 9:30am in St Mary's Church**. Parents of children who will be leaving the school are invited to join us for this celebration.

Meal Price Increase – From September the cost of a school meal (KS2 Only) will increase from £2.80 to **£2.90**.

Fareham and Gosport Family Centre Holiday Support (F&GFC) - To ensure that parents continue to feel supported throughout the holidays, F&GFC will be offering weekly drop-in support sessions in both Fareham and Gosport. These sessions are available to any parent or carer who would like advice, guidance, or simply an opportunity to talk through any concerns while schools are closed. No referral is required, and parents can attend as and when needed.

In addition to the drop-in sessions, parents can also access 1:1 SOS (Stepping Out Stronger) sessions for those who would benefit from more personalised support and intervention, or book onto one of our parenting courses, which will commence during the autumn term. Information about all of these services are attached to this email.

Their aim is to ensure that families do not feel isolated during the summer break and that they know support remains available should they need it.
