Discipline Policy



In the very unlikely event of bad behaviour:

- * Name written on the board as a warning;
- Tick next to name results in a detention – loss of breaktime to reflect upon their choices.
- * If the poor choices continue, this results in the involvement of the School SLT and a letter is sent home to inform parents/carers of their behaviour.

PE Requirements

- *Swimming hats will be needed.
- *They will be expected to get themselves changed quickly!

Homework

- *Regular homework is set half-termly to be completed within a set time.

- National Curriculum tests in May of Year 6.

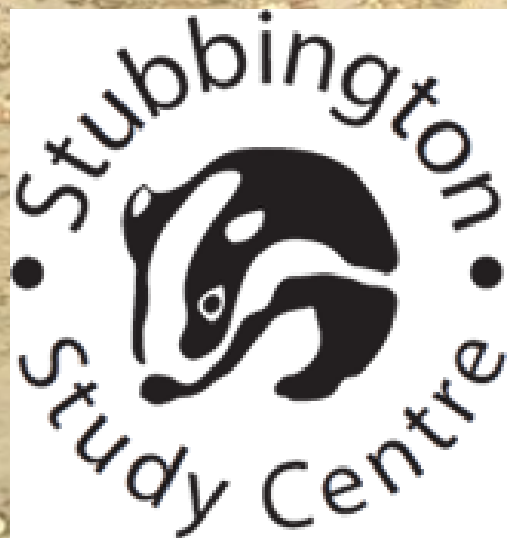
Extra-curricular Activities
