Mental Calculation Strategies for all 4 operations

Multiplying numbers up to 4 digits by two digits using formal methods

Addition and subtraction with formal methods

Converting between fractions, decimals and percentages.

Use all 4 operations to solve problems involving measure

Science: Animals Including Humans

Children will be able to describe the changes as humans develop to old age
They will compare the gestation periods of different mammals and explore data for patterns between animals and between lifespans and gestation periods.

Children will develop their drawing, painting and collage skills whilst learning about the artist Romare Bearden.



Ancient Greece

History: Ancient Greek Legacy

Children will build their knowledge and understanding of another ancient civilisation: Ancient Greece, including learning about politics /democracy, language, religion, architecture and The Olympics.

English:

Children will:

- Plan and write a new version of a Greek myth.
- Read a wide range of Greek myths and legends.
- Explore a narrative poem and use drama strategies to perform this.

PSHE: Keeping myself safe

Children will understand and give examples of things that might influence a person to take risks. They will consider a range of ways to keep themselves safe.

French: My Home

Children will complete a range of reading, listening, speaking and writing exercises about the topic 'My Home'.

PE: Cricket**Music: Greek Tragedy**

Children will develop their knowledge of dynamics, tempo and structure.

Computing: Character interviews

Children will explore the app 'Animate Anything' and create a character interview.

RE: Good and evil

Children will explain ways in which Hindus remember *good* and *evil* in the story and celebrations of Holi.
