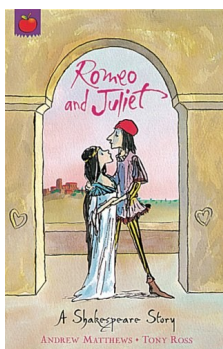
History: *Why does parliament run the country?*
