

YEAR 3



Maths: We will be continuing with all elements of Maths including: Place value & ordering, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, measurement including length time and money.

You can help your child at home by completing Mathletics activities (set on a Thursday from 24.9.26) and also by having a go at Times Tables Rockstars.

Please ask your child's teacher if you need any help with logs.

PE: Our main PE day will be Friday and we will be learning various sporting skills, please bring in the appropriate clothing for your child to wear outside. We will also have mini PE sessions where our focus will be passing skills.

DT We will be evaluating current designs of chocolate boxes and then designing and making boxes using nets, making a mood board and then decorating a box. We may also use computers to aid our design in seesaw.

RE: Our focus this half term will be a from the Christian perspective and we will be looking at Creation. We will be revisiting the Creation story and discussing what Christians believe the message from God was about how to look after the Earth.

English: We will be writing instructions for how to make a chocolate bar that we have designed. We will then make an advert to try and sell our chocolate bars. We will then be writing to Mr Chocworth to persuade him to sell our amazing chocolate bars.

We will be keeping our comprehension skills going by reading fiction and non fiction texts and discussing questions.

We will be learning spelling patterns and developing grammar skills from the Year 3 curriculum.



Computing: Microsoft Word skills linking in with adverts about chocolate. Using copy and paste, changing font/colour/size, inserting pictures. Any practice at home is very useful.

French: We start our journey in to French by learning the numbers from 0-12. We will then go on to learn: colours, days of the week, months of the year and more. We are learning the French phonics as we go.

PSHE: Our first unit is 'Me and My Relationships' where we will be looking at the diverse relationships we have with different groups of people. We will be focusing on rules to keep ourselves safe and looking at settling into a new school year with team work challenges to help us to get to know new classmates and to build our resilience to tasks.

Geography: Children will learn about economic activity linked to chocolate and how the UK is connected to the Ivory Coast through trade. They will continue to develop their knowledge of Africa recalling their Year 2 work on Ghana and seeing the links to Cote d'Ivoire.

Science: We have 3 science units this half term: skeletons, movement and nutrition and diet.
