

**Maths:**

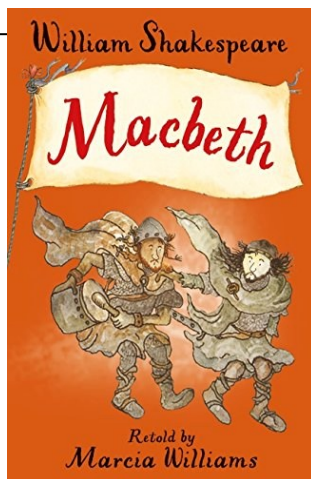
- Times tables.
- Multiplication and division using different methods.
- Addition and subtraction using different methods.
- Find the perimeter of shapes.
- Equivalent fractions and decimals.
- Compare and classify shapes- focusing on angles.
- Work through multi-step questions.
- Problem solving skills.

Science:

Children will learn about different habitats, food chains and the effects of deforestation.

Longitudinal Study:

Understanding the type of trees that grow in our school environment and how their seasonal changes impact on the habitats and wildlife around them.

**DT:**

Children will explore levers and linkages and create a card with moving parts.

English

Children will explore different versions of Shakespeare's 'Macbeth' and will:

- Write a play script for the scene between the Witches, Macbeth and Banquo.
- Improve dialogue between two characters.
- Create a poem based on the witches' spell.
- Write a review of the Mary Rose trip.

History:

Local Study:

Children will explore Tudor life, William Shakespeare, Henry VIII and The Mary Rose.

PSHE:

Growing and Changing

Children will discuss how they feel through different changes in their lives. E.g. moving house. Children will discuss the changes that will happen to their body as they grow up.
