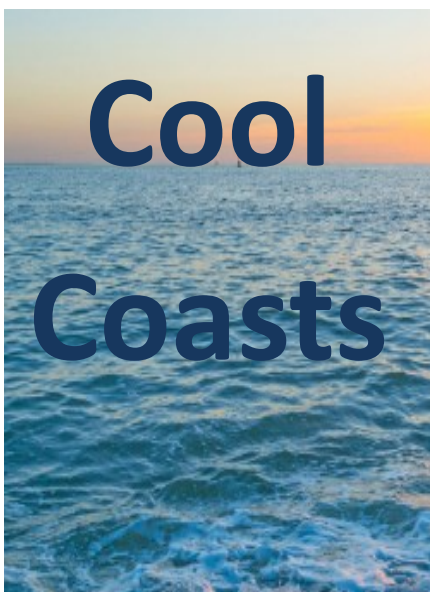

Computing We going to be using Scratch jnr to write a program for a robot. We will think about a job that we want them to do for us.
