Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is wraparound care?

Wraparound care is the childcare that 'wraps around' the normal school day, and allows parents to be able to work longer hours knowing that their children are being safely cared for. Wraparound care at HWW will be term time only, with IDPE Sports continuing to provide holiday care.

2. Who will manage before and after school care at HWW?

From September 2024 the Wraparound care at HWW will be managed and run by HWW staff.

3. What time will the before and after school club start and finish?

7.30am – 8.50am in the morning and 3.20pm – 6.00pm

4. How much will it cost?

The charges from September 2026 are: Mornings £7.00 and afternoons £14.50. This will be a one off payment even if a child is picked up early/late. Payment will be requested on a half-termly basis and can be paid via Scopay. There will be no refund for early/late pickups due to illness, however if enough notice is given for holidays that can be discussed. We politely request at least 30 days if you need to cancel and require a refund. Prices may be reassessed on an annual basis.

5. Can I pay using Childcare vouchers?

Yes, you can pay using Childcare vouchers. Please complete the Childcare voucher form in your joining pack or email wraparoundcare@warsash.hants.sch.uk

6. Will staff be fully trained?

Yes, all staff will be fully trained with First Aid, Food Preparation and Safeguarding. At least one member of staff will have their Paediatric 1st Aid (PFA) Certificate and everyone else will have a First Aid at work certificate.

7. Where will the before and after school club be located?

The new building will be purpose built for wraparound care and will be next to the existing environmental room and adjoined by a small, covered walk way.

8. Will the children have food provided?

A healthy, nutritious breakfast will be provided in the mornings. The cut off time for breakfast will be 8.10am. Food will also be provided in the afternoons.

9. What activities will be available for children?

Children at the Breakfast and after school club will have a range of play activities – including craft, Lego, cars, board games, puzzles, dolls, K’nex and much more. There will be an interactive white board in the room. The children will be encouraged to spend as much time as possible outside making use of the school’s outdoor space. Wi-Fi will be available.

10. Will you follow the school policies and procedures?

11. Will the building be secure?

The building will be fully secured with new fencing around the perimeter. The doors are secure and a buzz in doorbell has been installed.

12. Who do you contact for more information?

13. Will there be a waiting list?

Once full capacity is reached a waiting list will start. Priority will be given to siblings.

14. What is your capacity for each session?

Full capacity for each session will be 50 children.

15. What is your policy on late collections?

If a child is picked up late, a charge of £5 will be made for every 15 minutes beyond the collection time. This will commence from the 3rd time the child is collected late.

16. If my child falls into the Pupil Premium category for Free School Meals (FSM) will there be any help with payment of this wraparound care?

A conversation with the Head teacher would be necessary.

17. What happens if my child is ill?

The usual HWW school sickness policy applies to the breakfast and after school club. If your child is ill the 1st then 2nd and finally 3rd emergency contact will be called to collect.

18. Will there be ad-hoc places available for either breakfast or after school club if my child is not a regular Club attendee?
